

Swim Lesson Instructor

Work Location: Clear Creek Recreation Center in Idaho Springs

Swim Lesson Instructors are responsible for teaching students water safety and swimming instruction as based on the Clear Creek Swim Lesson curriculum.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Provides swim instruction as described in the Clear Creek Swim Lesson curriculum.
- Evaluates students' progress.
- Completes required paperwork in a timely manner.
- Maintains regular communication with parents/guardians regarding swim lesson activities and the progression of their child(ren)'s swim skills.
- Ensures that all lesson equipment is properly maintained and stored in an organized manner.
- Attends all scheduled and required in-service training sessions.
- Reports any and all complaints, accidents, and incidents to the lifeguard on duty, Head Lifeguard, and the Director of Programming and Communications in a timely manner, providing documentation as directed.
- Works in partnership with Head Lifeguards and lifeguard(s) on duty, to ensure that all aquatic facility policies, rules, and regulations are adhered to.
- Effectively recognizes and responds to emergency situations.
- Responds to patron complaints and concerns in a professional manner.
- Works in cooperation with all staff, across all departments.
- Maintains required certifications.
- Other duties as assigned.

SPAN OF SUPERVISION

• Reports to the Director of Programming and Communications

SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS

Must be 17 years of age or older.

- Must possess current American Red Cross CPR and AED (or a willingness to obtain upon hire).
- Must be able to satisfactorily pass swim assessment (basic knowledge of freestyle, backstroke, and breaststroke required).
- Must possess problem solving and critical thinking skills for identifying and resolving challenges to effective instruction.
- Must possess excellent communication and public relation skills.
- Must have the ability to work independently and as a member of a team.

EXPERIENCE

• Previous experience as a certified lifeguard, youth sports instructor/coach, camp counselor, or as a childcare professional preferred.

PHYSICAL & MENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to work as a member of a team.
- Requires alertness, precision, memory, concentration, judgment, reasoning, patience, problem solving, imagination, creativity, and innovation.
- Must be able to react efficiently and appropriately to potential mentally and physically stressful situations.
- Hearing must be adequate to hear noise up to 25 yards away.
- Required to safely lift a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Vision must be 20/20 or correctable.
